# Issue: S4 Leak from Elbow Connected to the Cooling Coil

#### Cause:

The elbow fitting that connects to the cooling coil is not fully seated onto the coil stem coming up from the coldwater bath. This is causing a leak to present itself upon dispensing cold water, Fig.1.

#### **Solution:**

Push elbow fitting down until it is fully seated on the cooling coil stem using needle nose pliers to hold the stem in place.

### Process: Approx 15-minute repair.

- 1. Unplug the unit from the outlet and ensure that water to the unit is turned off.
- 2. Remove the top and left side panels of the unit.
- 3. Make sure that the leak stop is not engaged, if it is, clear the leak and dry the floor pan.
- 4. Locate the elbow on the left side of the cold-water bath lid.
- 5. Pull the fitting up to expose the cooling coil stem.
- 6. Using needle nose pliers, gently hold the stem in place while pushing down on the elbow to seat it all the way down on the stem, Fig.2.
- 7. Plug unit back into the outlet, turn the water supply on and dispense cold water to ensure the leak is resolved.
- 8. Reasemble unit.
