Issue: S4 Slow or No Dispense from Hot Water

Cause:

The tubing from the out port of the hot water solenoid is not fully seated onto the stem of the faucet manifold.

Solution:

Push tubing fully onto faucet manifold.

Process: Approx 15-minute repair.

- 1. Unplug the unit from the outlet.
- 2. Remove the front panel on the S4, the top and side panels need to be removed first. If the unit is fixed on a base stand, the bolts that hold the unit onto the stand must be loosened to remove the side panels.
- 3. Locate the tubing on the out port of the hot dispense solenoid in Fig.1.
- 4. Following the tubing up to the faucet manifold, notice that the tubing is not fully seated onto the faucet manifold stem, creating a kink in the tubing. Fig. 2.
- 5. Push tubing fully onto the stem of the faucet manifold, eliminating the kink. NOTE: Tubing will contain hot water, execute this step with care. Fig. 3.
- 6. Plug unit back into the outlet and dispense hot water to ensure better flow.
- 7. Reasemble unit.




